DEAR PARISHIONERS and VISITORS:

This solemnity goes back to the 13th century. It was first established in one of the dioceses in France, and Pope Urban IV instituted it in 1264 for the whole Church.

The meaning of this feast is the consideration of and the devotion to the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Pope Urban IV wrote that the feast should be celebrated with hymns and joy in the Lord.

In 1264, Saint Thomas Aquinas, at the request of the Pope, composed for this day two prayer Offices which have nourished the devotion of Catholics to the Eucharist throughout the centuries. In this set of prayers are the Eucharistic hymns we know and love:

1. Panis Angelicus (Bread of Angels)
2. Adore te Devote (Humbly I adore thee)
3. O Salutaris hostia (O saving victim)
4. Pange Lingua Corperis (Now, my tongue, the mystery telling)
5. Tantum Ergo Sacramentum (Come Adore)

Please plant spend some extra time on Corpus Christi Sunday, either with our public devotions or quiet prayer, thanking Jesus for His greatest gift to us, His real Body and real Blood in the Eucharist.


