

DEAR PARISHIONERS and VISITORS:



As we move along in Lent towards Holy Week, the candidates for baptism at the Easter Vigil are asked to participate in three scrutinies during the Sunday Masses in Lent. The scrutinies are rites for self-searching and repentance. They are meant to help uncover and heal all that is weak, disordered or sinful in the hearts of these candidates.

These rites help to complete the conversion of the candidates and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Jesus and to carry out their decision to love God above all things.

These scrutinies are conducted after the homily at the 11:00 am Mass of the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sunday of Lent. The readings at each of these Masses come from Year A of the liturgical cycle instead of Year C that is the usual this year. On the Third Sunday of Lent for the scrutiny we will have the Gospel of the woman at the well; for the Fourth Sunday of Lent, the Gospel of the man born blind; and the Fifth Gospel will be the raising of Lazarus from the dead.

The scrutinies will help all the congregation to progress in their understanding of sin and their desire for salvation and the mercy of God.


