**DEAR PARISHIONERS and VISITORS:**

Monday, April 25 is the feast of Saint Mark the Evangelist. Scripture scholars tell us that there are two reasons why Mark's Gospel is of great importance. First, it is the earliest of all the gospels, probably written about AD 65. Second, it embodies the record of what Saint Peter preached and taught about Jesus. . . so it has a fascinating source of information about the life of Jesus.

There are some characteristics that are special to Mark's Gospel:

1) Mark never forgot the divine side of Jesus. He begins his Gospel with the declaration of faith "the beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God."

2) at the same time Mark gives us a very human picture of Jesus. . . that he got tired and wanted to rest ( Mk 6.31). So we get a very real set of snapshots of Jesus in action . . . vivid and engaging because Peter the Apostle was there and Mark records it.

What is helpful to us to appreciate more deeply Jesus Christ is to read Mark's Gospel in one sitting. . . that takes one hour or so because it is the shortest of the four Gospels.

To ponder for a few minutes God's over-arching plan of salvation through the window of St Mark's entire Gospel is highly recommended.

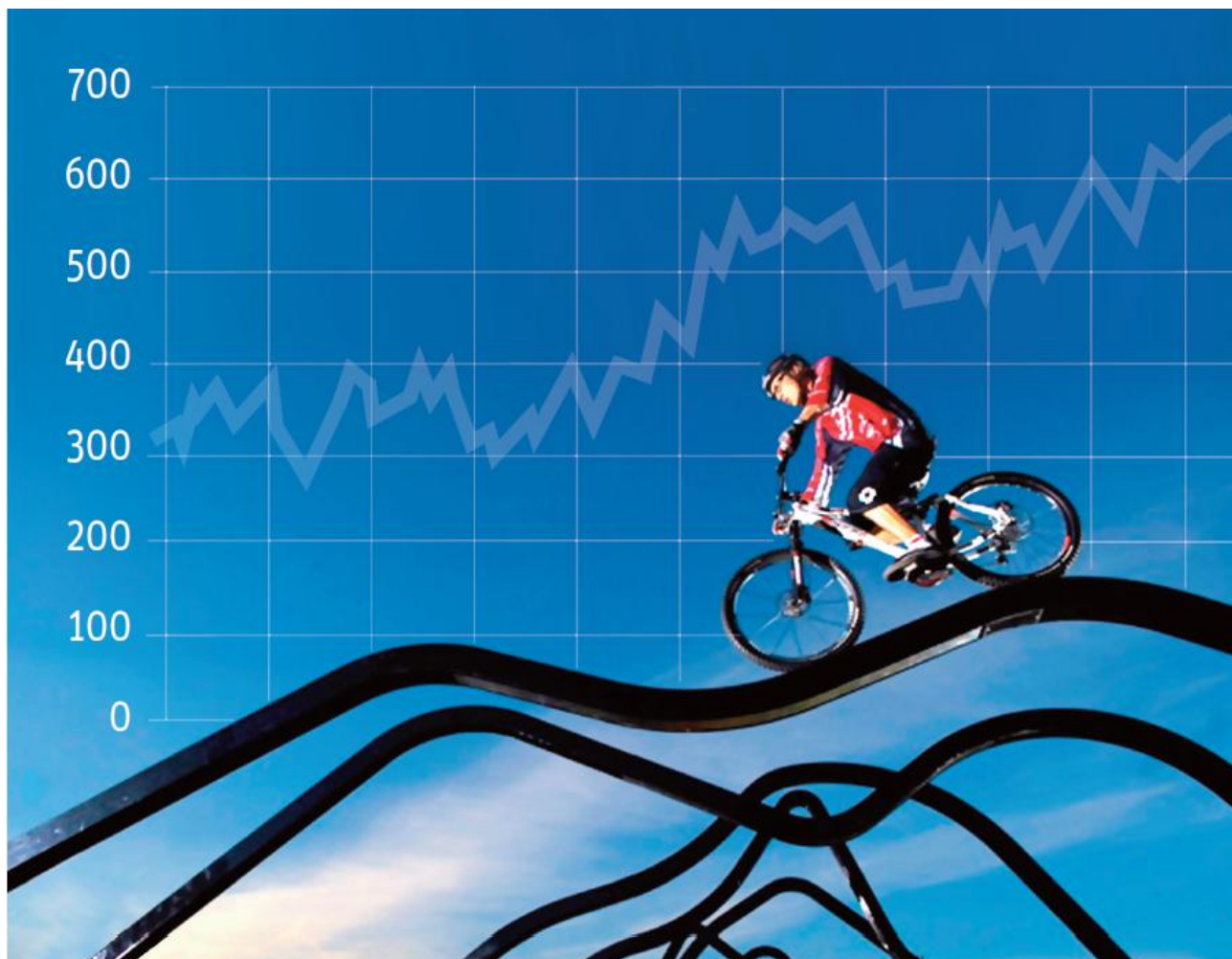
