DEAR PARISHIONERS and VISITORS:

Last Sunday at the 11:00 am Mass we celebrated the Rite of Acceptance for adults who seek baptism at Easter time or a profession of faith in the Catholic Church (if they are already baptized in another Christian group). This is part of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA).

The Canadian bishops describe the RCIA in this way: “ (it) is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and can conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. By God’s help they are strengthened spiritually during their preparation and at the proper time will receive the sacraments fruitfully.”

The Rite of Acceptance is meant to introduce the candidates to the parish community for prayerful support. 
