

DEAR PARISHIONERS and VISITORS:

Sometimes people ask us why we use different numbers of candles on the altar at Mass. According to Bishop Peter Elliott, the well known liturgist, there are only four possibilities in the Roman Rite: two, four, six, and seven. The seven candles applies only when the bishop celebrates a Mass.

As to the other possibilities, Bishop Elliott says that a good custom has arisen of using two candles for ferial Masses and memorials, four candles for feasts, and six for Sundays and solemnities.

The meaning of the candle is that as it burns down it reminds us of the "emptying" of ourselves at Mass in union with the sacrifice of Jesus. Turning away from pride and selfishness allows us to be more filled with the graces we get from the heavenly Father through Jesus


