EL SEÑOR PREDICABA CON PARÁBOLAS

El Señor utilizaba dos géneros oratorios: la predicación en discurso directo y la predicación por medio de parábolas, según el estilo de los rabinos de su época. Las parábolas por analogía o semejanza, se deriva una enseñanza relativa a un tema que no es el explícito. Este recurso en la predicación hace pensar, suscita la reflexión e invita al oyente a optar por una decisión. En tiempo de Nuestro Señor, la comunicación de la enseñanza mediante parábolas era muy común entre los rabinos. A los Apóstoles les parecía extraño que también Jesús se dirigiera al gran público con parábolas. De allí la pregunta que le hacen: “¿Por que les hablas en parábolas?”

LA SEMILLA DE LA PALABRA

En esta parábola está en primer plano el sembrador: Dios. Se puede también pensar que en la parábola Jesús se presenta a sí mismo en su misión oficial, pero es mejor poner en primer plano a Dios, porque la semilla, que Él siembra desde siempre en los corazones de los hombres, es la “Palabra de Dios”. En esta perspectiva la semilla es el mismo Cristo, porque Él es el Verbo de Dios, es decir la Palabra eterna de Dios, *aquello que Dios siempre ha dicho a los hombres.*
