**ANOINTING OF THE SICK, JANUARY 24, 12:10 PM MASS**

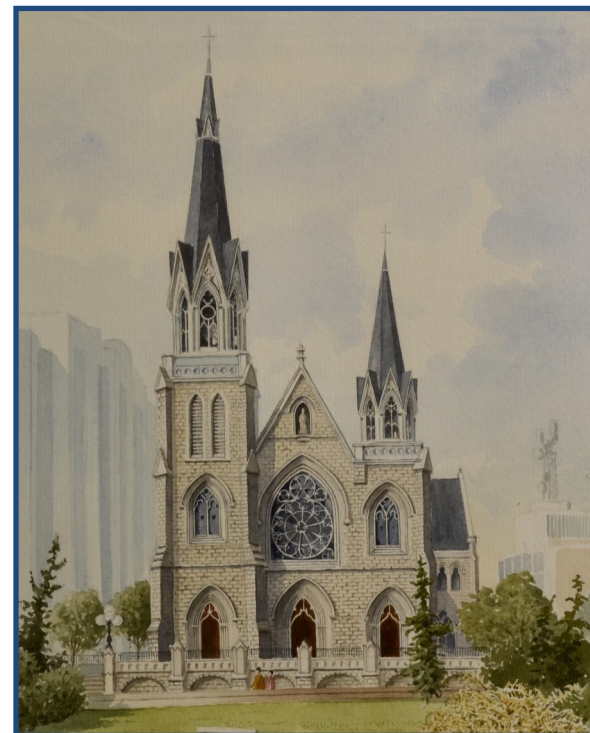

**MESSAGE FROM THE RECTOR**

The theme of this week of prayer for Christian unity is reconciliation. The associated verses from the bible are from II Corinthians 5, 14 - 20 which says "the love of Christ compels us...."

Some people have asked where does this week of prayer for Christianity come from? It was first proposed in 1908 as an observance within the Roman Catholic church by Fr. Paul Wattson, founder of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement.

Since the founding of the World Council of Churches in 1948, many other Christian groups around the world have come to celebrate this week of prayer for Christian unity.

Every year then, between January 18<sup>th</sup> (the remembrance of the confession of Saint Peter) and January 25<sup>th</sup> (the feast of the conversion of Saint Paul), Christians around the world are invited to celebrate a week of prayer for the unity of all Christians.
