

Dear Parishioners,

This year's Project Advance Appeal is a major shift from those of the past. The response of the Archdiocese of Vancouver to the Covid-19 crisis has made this necessary. The Archdiocesan goal for this year is \$1.625 million, much lower than it has been in recent years.

Archdiocesan funds for this year's appeal will be directed mainly to the new Crisis Response Fund to help vulnerable individuals and families affected by the pandemic. Funds will also support a variety of other outreach and evangelization ministries.

The Cathedral's own response to the challenges posed by the crisis has uncovered new areas of need. The diocesan target set for the Cathedral is \$38,500 but our own parish target is \$77,000.

These extra funds rebated to the parish will go toward plexiglass shields for the upper level stained glass windows, a fund for security guards on special occasions and equipment for improved internet connection in Rosary Hall. In summary, funds are needed to better secure our premises, protect parishioners and help us evangelize more effectively in this digital era.

## LIMITED PUBLIC CELEBRATION OF MASS AND CONFESSION

1) The directives of the BC Health Authorities allow the Cathedral to offer the public celebration of Mass for **fifty people or less** (including people at the altar and loft). Proper social distancing and cleansing are required. Anyone who plans on coming to Mass, **must meet the health requirements** and safety precautions set by the authorities.

2) Because of limited resources for security and cleansing, there will be **three Sunday Masses available for public celebration: 8 AM, 11 AM and 6:30 PM (Spanish)**. These Masses will also be live-streamed. The 8 PM Sunday Mass will be live-streamed with no public present.

2) **BC Health Authorities also require that an accurate record of names and contact information be kept of each member of the faithful attending public Masses.**

To facilitate this, **attendance at Sunday public Masses requires you to sign up on the Cathedral website (holyrosarycathedral.org)** Click on the **Mass Sign up button** on the homepage, check if there are slots available for the Mass time you wish to attend, then fill in your name and contact information. **Sign up will be available until 3 PM on Thursday ( or until all attendance slots are full).** After that time you will no longer be able to sign up for the upcoming Sunday Mass. A new link will be posted each Monday morning which will allow you to sign up for the upcoming Sunday Mass.

Please call us on Monday **if you don't have a computer** and need help signing-up for the upcoming Sunday Mass. **We will not be able to add you to a Mass that is already full.** Please note, **you will only be admitted to Mass if you receive a confirmation email or phone call** that your name is on the list for the Sunday Mass you selected.

3) **Entry to the Cathedral for Sunday Mass will be only by the East door in the lane.** No access is available at the front doors on Dunsmuir street. **Doors will open for admission 30 minutes before Mass starts and will close 15 minutes before Mass begins.**

**Rosary Hall is closed at this time and no public washrooms are available.**

4) **Weekday Masses** (Monday-Saturday) will resume on Monday, June 29. The 12:10 PM and 5:10 PM Masses will be open to the public. The 7:15 AM Mass will be live-streamed with no public present. Sign-up will take place at the door (50 person limit will be in effect). **Doors will open at 11:50 AM and close at 12:05 PM sharp for 12:10 PM Mass. Doors will open again at 4:50 PM and close at 5:05 PM sharp for the 5:10 PM Mass. Please enter through East door in the lane and make sure to maintain proper distancing when lining up outside.**

**The Cathedral will remain closed in between Masses.**
