2023 PROJECT ADVANCE

Dear Friends & Parishioners,

The theme of this year's Project Advance is Empowering Our Parish Vision. It is a call for all parishes to look ahead and plan carefully for what they would like to accomplish in the coming years.

Thanks to your generosity, last year we raised \$146,852 which brought us \$65,783 in rebates. This helped us begin the roof upgrade of Rosary Hall. We still have to raise \$48,000 to complete this work.

Because the Cathedral is a heritage building, we have to take care of maintenance as well long-term needs. A priority in this list is engineering tests to help us understand how the Cathedral will stand up to various types of earthquakes. The following initiatives are necessary and prudent for safety and budgeting purposes.

Project 1: Test the soil on which our building stands to assess its loadbearing capacity. We need geotechnical engineers to do this.

Project 2: Test the strength and durability of the sandstone wall and pillar structures. We need structural engineers to evaluate this.

The approximate cost of these two assessments is \$50,000.

In this year's Project Advance appeal, the diocesan allotment for Holy Rosary Cathedral is \$70,200.

After raising this amount, remaining funds will be rebated to us. I'm setting our total target at \$140,000 to cover the Archdiocesan goal and partial expenses for our own projects.
