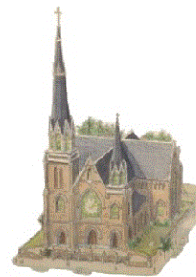

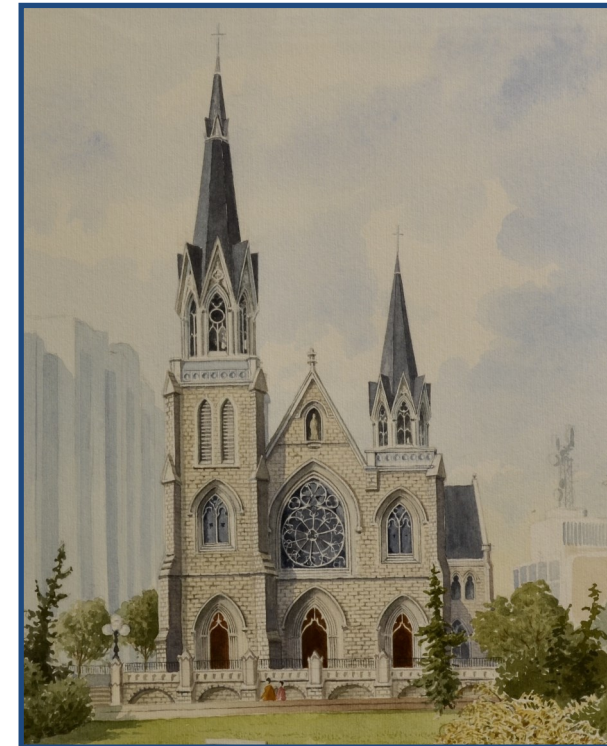

PROJECT ADVANCE 2023 REVIEW

Dear friends in Christ,

Thank you for your generous response to last year's Project Advance appeal. As you well know, Project Advance enables us each year, to come together as a faith community to support the ministries and programs of the Archdiocese as well as the needs of parishes.

Last year, there was a special emphasis placed on empowering parishes to equip themselves with the resources they need to carry out the work of mission and evangelization.

At the Cathedral, we set our priorities on two projects related to maintenance and the long-term needs for the safe use of our 122-year-old heritage building. Your kind response to these needs is indeed making this work possible.

Here's a quick overview. Our portion of last year's appeal set by the PA office was \$70,200. This is to support the Archdiocese's goals for pastoral formation, youth and young adult ministry and outreach programs for those in need.

Our own Cathedral goal was to raise an additional \$69,800 to meet maintenance and safety-related needs. Thanks to early donations, by July we were able to reach our diocesan goal. By the end of the year, we went beyond \$150,000. This was indeed good news. I'm happy to report that the total rebate to the Cathedral, minus expenses billed by the Project Advance office, is \$75,651.44.

Thank you again for your kind response to Project Advance 2023.
