MOTHER'S DAY

Cardinal József Mindszenty once said that "the most important person in the world is a mother. She cannot claim the honour of having built Notre Dame Cathedral. She need not. She has built something more magnificent than any cathedral: an abode for an immortal soul, the tiny perfection of her baby's body... Angels are not blessed with such grace. They cannot participate in God's creative miracle to bring new saints into heaven. Only a human mother can do that. Mothers are closer to God the Creator than any other creature; God joins forces with mothers to perform this act of creation... What on God's good earth is more glorious than this: to be a mother?"

This Sunday we remember Mother's day, and although we should remember our moms every day, this day is given to us to remind us to show more intently our love for them. And a great way to show love and gratitude for our moms is prayer. Ask God to bless her, to fill her with inner peace, to give her health, to give her strength, to give her what she needs most, to give her the gift of His eternal embrace at the end of her life. You probably know what her main worries her and what she needs, perhaps she has told you and has even asked you to put her intentions in the hands of God and Mary. Support her, listen to her when she asks for help with your prayers. And for those whose mom is in heaven, whenever the memory of your mom comes back to you, do not forget to commend her to God, asking Him to fill her in heaven with the love and happiness that He Himself promised us, and which she somehow showed you on earth, anticipating for you a taste of the happiness of the children of God. Ask her also to intercede with God our Lord for you, so that one day the whole family may be reunited in heaven.
